### **Target**

- In this project our target despite the 60 stakeholders (water operators and doctors and representatives of local communities) was pupils from 2 primary schools near Skopje.
- We worked with 120 pupils and 20 teachers
- by participating in summer camps, workshops, debates, lectures

## How we select the two schools?

- In selecting the schools with which we cooperate we watched to choose two schools with different levels of access to water and sanitation...
- To be in rural area
- To be interested in cooperation on this issues
- To have multiethnic and different understandings regarding access to sanitation and managing menstrual hygiene

### We choose...

Primary school Diutria is village of Saraj

Regional school in village Color municipality Studenicani





#### Why we select this two schools?

- Both school are in rural area...
- Saraj in village of Saraj, on 10 km from Skopje
- Cvetovo in the village of Cvetovo, in the area of the municipality Studenicani
- In schools children from different ethnic backgrounds: Macedonians, Albanians, Turks, Roma ... predominantly Muslim population





## Why we select this 2 schools?

Diutria primary school was renovate and WASH was on high level

Primary school in Cvetovo despite that was renovate the WASH was on very low level

► 120 pupils from 2 primary schools receive the new knowledge about water and sanitation

4 summer camps was realized in the frame of summer activities during the summer holiday





# Menstrual Hygiene management caused the greatest attention among students

 8 workshops on different topic was organized in the period of September - November 2016

► The pupils visit Rasche village where is the source water supply for Skopje





#### What they learn?

- **About MHM**

- About personal hygiene How to protect water How to clean and maintain sanitation
- To test the water safety









#### Results:

- ▶ 120 pupils from 2 primary schools receive the new knowledge about water and sanitation
- 4 summer camps was realized in the frame of summer activities during the summer holiday
- 8 workshops on different topic was organized in the period of September - November 2016
- The pupils visit the WSSP in Rashtak and learn how to protect our water source...

#### Follow up

- To continue educating students
- To work on educating teachers
- To lobby compendium become part of the regular curriculum in primary school (for now it is used as additional classes in 5 primary schools in the municipality of Aerodrom)
- To start and adapt the compendium for children in kinder garden
