


Situation in remote areas of Georgia

- Wide spread energy poverty
- Dependence on firewood for water heating, heating and cooking
- Lack of participation opportunities for citizens



Usage of 10-14m² firewood per household / year





Impact esp. on women

- Labour burden
- Indoor air pollution
- Deforestation
- => increasing cost and effort of fuel



Energy cooperatives are ...


A cooperative is a voluntary association of persons (women and men) with the aim to generate benefits for the members through a common business operation. Energy cooperatives promote the common idea of the members and allows through including the civil society a broad bottom-up development



- ... democratic:
 one member one vote, small-volume
- ... flexible easy way to become a member and to exit
- ... secure: nearly no insolvencies and risk diversion
- ... ethical: as ecological investment
- ... expandable: for more projects in the region
- ... economic: attractive and ecological investment
- ... sustainable: energy production free of nuclear and carbon
- ... participative and decentral
 people can create the energy turnaround from bottom up with small amounts

4 Gender Just Energy Cooperatives

- 40% women in board and membership
- Aiming 50%



Gender Sensitive Energy Cooperatives

Gender equality institutionalized in the energy cooperatives

Increase women's participation through clear gender strategies:

- → In the statutes it has quota in board for women in the board aiming 50%)
- → Stimulation of women membership (cost 25 euro)
- → Leadership training for women in management
- → Awareness raising on gender and the importance of women equal particiation for women and men

Gender equality results:

- More women have control over energy production
- More women are empowered & learn leadership skills
- Employment for women & men
- Income from dividend

Cooperatives sell three types of products




Fuel Efficient Stove (FES)

- Double combustion mechanism
- use of dry wood
- avoid of indoor air pollution

Solar Water Heater

- Replace firewood stoves
- Local production and easy repair
- Provision of warm water throughout the day
- Expected lifetime: 25 years
- 600 SWHs already installed and in operation

Thermal Insulation

- window re-fitting
- insulation of attics
- Successfully tested in pilot phase













Where Do We Stand?

- Many women involved and motivated but there are challenges
- Traditional roles (husbands don't allow wives to work, attend community meetings or trainings...)
- Gender-based violence (at home, public transport, workplace...)
- Stereotypes (women shouldn't be technical)
- Quotas work: 40% of women, critical mass make change)






